## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Conference Committee Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1002

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 secretary of state and public printing; to provide for a transfer; to provide legislative intent; to
- 3 provide a contingent appropriation; to provide an exemption; and to amend and reenact
- 4 sections 16.1-01-15 and 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to interest
- 5 earnings on the election fund and to the salary of the secretary of state.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:
