- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the securities
- 2 commissioner; and to provide for a legislative council study.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other income, to the 7

securities commissioner of the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the

8 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

- 2 2011-13 biennium. The securities commission shall report to the appropriations committees of
- 3 the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- 4 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - SECURITIES COMMISSIONER

- 6 **FEES.** During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying the structure
- 7 and appropriateness of the level of fees charged by the securities commissioner. The
- 8 legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
- 9 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
