- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the securities
- 2 commissioner; and to provide for a legislative council study.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other income, to the securities commissioner of the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - SECURITIES COMMISSIONER

- 6 **FEES.** During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying the structure
- 7 and appropriateness of the level of fees charged by the securities commissioner. The
- 8 legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
- 9 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
