1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

5	The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the				
6	2011-13 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committee of the				
7	sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium				
8	beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.				
9	SECTION 3. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE - TRANSFERS. The highway patrol is				
10	authorized to transfer from the deferred maintenance line to the other lines contained in				
11	section 1 of this Act, amounts necessary to address extraordinary repair needs. Any amounts				
12	transferred must be reported to the director of the office of management and budget.				
13	SECTION 4. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER. The less estimated income line item in				
14	section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$4,550,725, or so much of the sum as may be				
15	necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the				
16	direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses				
17	of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.				
18	SECTION 5. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATRO	L OFFICERS. Each	patrol officer of		
19	the state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an				
20	amount not to exceed \$220 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending				
21	June 30, 2011. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for means and other expenses,				
22	except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North DAkota or while at their respective				
23	home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are				
24	paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or				
25	other memorandums.
