1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information

2 technology department.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the 8 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, 9 as follows:

necessary to address extraordinary repair needs. Any amounts transferred must be reported tothe director of the office of management and budget.

SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget shall make transfers of funds between the salaries and wages, operating expenses, and capital assets lines items in section 1 of this Act for the information technology department as may be requested by the chief information officer as determined necessary for the development and implementation of information technology projects.
