4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-53-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 54-53-02. Advisory transportation council Composition. There is established a
 transportation council that shall serve in an advisory capacity to the upper great plains
- 9 transportation institute. The director of the institute shall serve as the executive secretary of the
- 10 council. The council shall elect its own chairman. The council membership consists of one
- 11 representative from and appointed by the following:
- 1. The greater North Dakota chamber of commerce.
- 13 2. The North Dakota public service commission.
- 14 3. The North Dakota farm bureau.
- 15 4. The North Dakota farmers union.
- 16 5. The North Dakota grain growers association.
- 17 6. The North Dakota state wheat commission.
- 18 7. The North Dakota department of commerce.
- 19 8. The North Dakota grain dealers association.
- 20 9. The North Dakota motor carriers association.
- 21 10. The North Dakota aeronautics commission.
- 22 11. The North Dakota department of transportation.
- 23 12. The North Dakota agriculture commissioner department of agriculture.
- 24 13. The North Dakota association of associated general contractors of North Dakota.

- 1 14. The North Dakota railway industry, appointed by the council.
- 2 15. The North Dakota primary sector of manufacturing, appointed by the council.
- 3 16. The North Dakota association of counties.
- 4 17. The North Dakota league of cities.
- 5 18. The lignite energy council.
- 6 19. The dakota transit association.
- Members of the council shall serve without pay, but they may receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, if authorized by the director.
- The council shall consult with the institute in matters of policy affecting the administration of this chapter and in the development of transportation in the state of North
- 12 Dakota. The council shall meet at the call of the executive chairman director or upon the
- 13 written request of three or more members of the council.
