- 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 43-30-02 of the North Dakota
 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 1. Any investigator or officer directly employed by or under any direct contract with 8 the federal government, state, or any county or city thereof, appointed, elected, or 9 contracted with, by due authority of law, while engaged in the performance of 10 official duties. Subcontractors of agencies directly contracted with these entities 11 are not exempted. A licensed peace officer or auxiliary officer employed by a law 12 enforcement agency may not work as a security officer unless: 13 The officer's law enforcement agency has been contracted to provide security a. 14 with all remunerations paid directly to that agency; or 15 The officer is employed by a private security service licensed under this b. 16 chapter and the officer is registered as required by this chapter.
