1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce to fund a
2 feasibility study for the construction of a marina and to the game and fish department to
3 construct a paved roadway and boat ramp.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much
7 of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for a grant to the New Town
8 Park Board, for the purpose of completing a feasibility study to construct a marina at Arrowhead
9 Point near New Town for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. This
10 study is to be completed in consultation with an advisory committee comprised of
11 representatives from the department of commerce, game and fish department, state parks and
12 recreation district, state water commission, New Town Park Board, Three Affiliated Tribes, and
13 local stakeholder groups.

14 There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not
15 otherwise appropriated , the sum of \$1,700,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary,
16 to the game and fish department for the purpose of constructing a paved roadway and boat
17 ramp near the marina at Arrowhead Point for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
18 June 30, 2011. The game and fish department may not spend the general fund moneys until
19 special funds, derived from federal funds or other private sources, are committed and secured
20 for the construction of a marina near this location.
