- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 16.1-13-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the call for a special election to fill vacancy in the United States House of
- 3 Representatives due to a catastrophic circumstance.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 16.1-13-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 6 enacted as follows:

16.1-13-08.1. Special election to fill a vacancy in the United States House of Representatives due to a catastrophic circumstance. If a vacancy occurs in the office of representative in congress due to a catastrophic circumstance in which one hundred or more representatives across the United States are no longer able to serve and the next regular or special election is more than seventy-five days in the future, the governor shall immediately issue a writ of election calling a special election to fill the vacancy. The date of the election shall be forty-nine days from the date of the proclamation and the following deadlines shall apply:

- 1. Certificate of endorsement as described in 16.1-11-09, affidavits of candidacy described in 16.1-11-10, and statements of interest described in 16.1-09-03 for those candidates nominated by political parties currently established in the state shall be filed with the secretary of state by four p.m. on the fortieth day before the election.
- If the election occurs in an election year, the precincts previously established by the county shall be utilized.
 - If the election occurs in a year without a scheduled election, the board of county commissioners must establish the precinct boundaries by the fortieth day before the election.

- The secretary of state shall certify to the county auditors the names of the
 candidates for the election on the thirty-ninth day before the election.
- 5. Absentee ballots shall be made available to qualified electors by the thirtieth day
 before the election.
