PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE AND HOUSE RULES 348

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Senate Rule 348 is amended: 1 2 348. CLINCHER MOTION. A motion that any action taken by the Senate be 3 reconsidered and that the motion to reconsider be laid on the table, if carried by a majority vote 4 of the member-elect, has the effect of preventing reconsideration except upon a two-thirds vote 5 of the members-elect. The motion must be decided without debate. 6 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** House Rule 348 is amended: 7 **348. CLINCHER MOTION.** A motion that any action taken by the House be 8 reconsidered and that the motion to reconsider be laid on the table, if carried by a majority vote 9 of the members-elect, has the effect of preventing reconsideration except upon a two-thirds 10 vote of the members-elect. The motion must be decided without debate.

NOTE: This proposed rules amendment is in response to a question as to the vote required to adopt a clincher motion in the Senate. Because Senate Rule 348 is silent as the vote required, the vote for a clincher motion is governed by Senate Rule 318(1)(m):

1. The following questions require a majority vote of the members of the Senate present and voting:
