HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3003

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the sustainability of tribal 2 social service programs. 3 WHEREAS, the rate of population growth on the state's Indian reservations is one of the 4 highest growth rates in the state; and 5 WHEREAS, high rates of poverty and unemployment on the state's Indian reservations 6 require strong, sustainable tribal social service programs; and 7 WHEREAS, tribal social service offices should be involved in the Department of Human 8 Services' budgeting process in consultation with the involvement of county social service 9 offices; and 10 WHEREAS, involvement of tribal social service offices will help the state to identify 11 social service needs on the state's reservations; 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 13 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 14 That the Legislative Council study the sustainability of tribal social service programs; 15 and 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council assign this study to an 17 interim Human Services Committee or other similar interim committee for study; and 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 19 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 20 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
