2009 HOUSE BILL NO. 1400

SECTION 61. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - SCHOOL APPROVAL AND

ACCREDITATION. During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying statutory criteria for the approval of public and nonpublic schools, regulatory criteria for the accreditation of schools, and the consequences to schools and school districts that fail to meet the criteria. In addition, the study must include a review of statutory sections that place specific requirements on school districts and the consequences to school districts that fail to abide by the requirements. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
