Page 18, line 5, after the underscored period insert "<u>A person that does not charge a fee or</u> otherwise receive consideration may assist employers, employees, and consumers in making health coverage decisions through use of the exchange without being certified under this subsection."

Page 18, after line 15, insert:

- "c. A certificate holder may not in a single transaction charge a fee and receive consideration from a health insurance issuer in connection with the enrollment of a qualified individual or qualified employees in a qualified health plan."
- Page 22, line 30, after the underscored period insert "<u>To the extent the division's proposal</u> includes the collection of funds that are based on insurance, the division shall consult with the commissioner in designing the proposal."
- Page 22, line 31, after the underscored period insert "<u>To the extent the board's plan includes</u> the collection of funds that are based on insurance, the board shall consult with the commissioner."
- Page 23, line 9, remove ", in consultation with the commissioner,"
- Page 23, line 12, after the underscored period insert "<u>If the board's funding plan includes the</u> <u>collection of funds that are based on insurance, upon request of the board the</u> <u>commissioner shall charge and collect such funds and shall deposit such funds in the</u> <u>health benefit exchange fund.</u>"
- Page 25, line 12, after "interim" insert "which must include monthly written reports on the status of state and federal funds received and the status of state and federal funds expended"

Page 27, after line 21, insert:

"SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. Creation of a state-administered health benefit exchange is not intended to express the sixty-second legislative assembly's support of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, but instead is intended to express its support of state control."
