7 1. "Administration" means the direct application of a drug to the body of a patient.

		<u>(a)</u>	Immunization and vaccination by injection of an individual who is more-
			than eighteenat least eleven years of age, upon an order by a
			physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe such a drug or-
			by written protocol with a physician or nurse practitioner; and
		<u>(b)</u>	Influenza vaccination by injection or by live, attenuated influenza
			vaccine of an individual who is at least five years of age; and
	(3)	Provision of drugs by subcutaneous, intradermal, and intramuscular	
		injection to an individual who is more thanat least eighteen years of age	
		upon the order of a physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe	
		such a drug.

- 2 a health care setting and other parenteral administration of a drug.
