- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 53 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to agritourism liability.

### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 53 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Definitions**.
- 7 <u>In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:</u>
- 8 <u>1. "Agritourism" means any activity customarily carried out on a working or historical</u>
- 9 <u>farm, ranch, forestry operation, or winery, if members of the general public are invited</u>
- 10 <u>to view or allowed to participate, with or without fees or charges, in the activities for</u>
- 11 educational, recreational, or entertainment purposes.
- 12 <u>2.</u> "Inherent risk" means:
- 13 <u>a.</u> Any condition, danger, or hazard that is a normal and customary part of an
- 14 <u>agritourism operation, including:</u>
- 15 (1) Surface and subsurface conditions of the land;
- 16 (2) Surface and subsurface conditions of the water;
- 17 (3) Natural conditions of vegetation;
- 18 (4) The behavior of wild or domestic animals; and
- 19 <u>(5)</u> <u>Structures and equipment; and</u>
- b. Any act of negligence on the part of a participant, including failing to follow
- 21 <u>instructions or failing to exercise reasonable caution while engaging in</u>
- 22 <u>agritourism.</u>
- 23 <u>3. "Participant" means a member of the general public who is invited to view or allowed</u>
- 24 <u>to participate in agritourism, with or without fees or charges.</u>

# 1 <u>Notice regarding liability - Requirements.</u>

- 2 The owner or operator of any facility at which agritourism occurs shall post in a conspicuous
- 3 <u>location on the premises and include in each written contract pertaining to an individual's</u>
- 4 participation in agritourism a notice indicating that under the laws of this state, the owner or
- 5 operator is not liable for any injury to or for the death of a participant if the injury or death results
- 6 from an inherent risk, as defined in this chapter.

## Participant in agritourism - Assumption of risk.

- 8 Except as otherwise provided, a participant assumes all inherent risks of agritourism. In any
- 9 <u>action for damages arising from an individual's participation in agritourism, the owner or</u>
- 10 operator of the facility at which the activity occurred may plead assumption of risk by the
- 11 participant as an affirmative defense.

# 12 <u>Liability of owner or operator.</u>

- 13 This chapter does not prevent or limit the liability of the owner or operator of an agritourism
- 14 <u>facility if the owner or operator:</u>
- 15 <u>1. Willfully injures a participant;</u>
- 16 <u>2. Has actual knowledge of a dangerous condition on the premises, does not make the</u>
- 17 <u>condition known to the participant, and the participant is injured as a result; or</u>
- 18 3. Provides faulty equipment to a participant and the participant is injured as a result.
