## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1142

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 53 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to registered agritourism activity liability.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 53 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
- 5 enacted as follows:
- 6 **Definitions**.

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- 7 In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 8 <u>1.</u> "Agritourism activity" means any activity, including farming and ranching activities, or
- 9 <u>any historic, cultural, or natural attraction, that is viewed or enjoyed by members of the</u>
- general public, for educational, recreational, or entertainment purposes, regardless of
- 11 whether the member of the general public pays to participate in the activity or to view
- or enjoy the attraction.
- 13 <u>2. "Inherent risk" means:</u>
- 14 a. Any condition or danger that is an integral part of agritourism, including:
- 15 (1) Surface and subsurface conditions of the land:
  - (2) Surface and subsurface conditions of the water;
- 17 (3) Natural conditions of land, vegetation, and water;
- 18 (4) The behavior of wild or domestic animals; and
- 19 (5) Structures and equipment ordinarily used in farming or ranching; and
- 20 <u>b.</u> The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner, including failing to
- 21 <u>follow instructions or failing to exercise reasonable caution while engaging in an</u>
- 22 <u>agritourism activity.</u>
- 23 <u>3. "Participant" means a member of the general public who engages in a registered</u>
- 24 agritourism activity.

- 4. "Registered agritourism activity" means an agritourism activity that is registered with
   the division of tourism.
- 3 <u>5.</u> "Registered agritourism operator" means a person that is registered with the division
   of tourism and that is engaged in the provision of a registered agritourism activity.

## 5 <u>Registration - Requirements.</u>

- 1. A person may become a registered agritourism operator by registering with the
   division of tourism.
- 8 <u>2. The registration must include a description of the agritourism activity that the person</u>
  9 <u>provides or intends to provide.</u>
- 10 3. The division of tourism may not impose any fees or other charges to register
   11 agritourism operators.
- 12 <u>4. A registration under this section is effective for five years.</u>
- 13 Registered agritourism operators Maintenance of list.
- 14 The division of tourism shall:
- 15 <u>1, Maintain a list of all registered agritourism operators; and</u>
- 16 <u>2. Maintain a list of all registered agritourism activities.</u>
- 17 <u>Notice regarding liability Requirements.</u>
- A registered agritourism operator shall post in a conspicuous location on the premises and
- 19 <u>include in each written contract pertaining to an individual's participation in agritourism a notice</u>
- 20 <u>indicating that under the laws of this state, the registered agritourism operator is not liable for</u>
- 21 any injury to or for the death of a participant if the injury or death results from an inherent risk.
- 22 Participant in agritourism activity Assumption of risk.
- 23 Except as otherwise provided, a participant assumes all inherent risks of agritourism. In any
- 24 <u>action for damages arising from an individual's participation in agritourism, a registered</u>
- 25 <u>agritourism operator may plead assumption of risk by the participant as an affirmative defense.</u>
- 26 <u>Liability of registered agritourism operator.</u>
- This chapter does not prevent or limit the liability of a registered agritourism operator if the operator:
- 29 <u>1. Injures a participant willfully or through conduct that amounts to gross negligence; or</u>
- 2. a. Has actual knowledge of or should have known of:

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1		<u>(1)</u>	A dangerous condition on property, including in a facility, at which a
2			registered agritourism activity occurs;
3		<u>(2)</u>	A dangerous condition with respect to equipment used in the registered
4			agritourism activity; or
5		<u>(3)</u>	The dangerous propensity of a particular animal used in the registered
6			agritourism activity:
7	<u>b.</u>	<u>Doe</u>	s not exercise ordinary care to remedy the danger or to warn a participant of
8		the ·	danger; and
9	<u>C.</u>	<u>The</u>	danger causes injury to the participant or contributes to the injury of the

11	Division of tourism - Copy of law - Provision to registered agritourism operator.		
2	The division of tourism shall provide a copy of the applicable law to each person that		
3	registers or reregisters as an agritourism operator.
