- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for funding a director of Indian education; and to
- 2 provide for a report to the legislative management.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$194,327, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of employing an individual to serve as the director of Indian education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. The director of Indian education shall develop and implement strategies to improve academic achievement, including achievement test scores, dropout rates, graduation rates, college preparedness, and college and workforce readiness.
- SECTION 2. DIRECTOR OF INDIAN EDUCATION REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT. The director of Indian education shall provide a progress report to the legislative management during the 2011-12 interim which addresses student achievement as measured by a statewide approved test, dropout rates, attendance, parent and community involvement, educational programs targeting Native American students, the current status of federal Indian education policies and procedures, and school district initiatives to decrease the number of student dropouts and increase graduation rates.
