- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-08-02, 4.1-08-06, and 4.1-08-07 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment on colonies of honeybees; to provide
- 3 an appropriation; to provide for a transfer; and to provide an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-08-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 4.1-08-02. Assessment.
- 8 An annual assessment in the amount of fiveten cents is imposed on each colony of
- 9 honeybees licensed by the beekeeper. The minimum annual assessment is one dollar.
- 10 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-08-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 11 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 4.1-08-06. Assessment Authorized expenditures.
- The assessment required by this chapter may be used to fund research, <u>including efforts</u>
- 14 that focus on honeybee colony health; education programs, and market development efforts,
- as well as promotional efforts such as the North Dakota honey gueen program.
- 16 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-08-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **4.1-08-07. Commissioner Powers.**
- 19 The commissioner may:
- 1. Expend moneys appropriated under this chapter for the purposes set forth in section
- 21 4.1-08-06, provided the commissioner first consults with a committee appointed bythe
- board of directors of the North Dakota beekeepers' association; and
- 2. Do all things necessary and proper to enforce and administer this chapter.

1 There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not-2 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be 3 necessary, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of providing grants to 4 public or private entities engaging in research efforts focusing on honeybee colony-5 health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. 6 Before the agriculture commissioner may award a grant under this section, the 7 commissioner shall obtain the consent of the board of directors of the North Dakota-8 beekeepers' association under section 4.1-08-07. 9 The agriculture commissioner may expend no more than fifty percent of the amount 10 appropriated by this section during the first year of the 2011-13 biennium. 11 4. Notwithstanding section 54-44.1-11, at the end of the 2011-13 biennium, the 12 agriculture commissioner shall transfer any unexpended and unobligated amount-13 appropriated by this section to the honey fund. 14 **SECTION 4.
