- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-08-02, 4.1-08-06, and 4.1-08-07 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the assessment on colonies of honeybees; and to
- 3 provide an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-08-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **4.1-08-02.** Assessment.

- 8 An annual assessment in the amount of <u>fiveten</u> cents is imposed on each colony of
- 9 honeybees licensed by the beekeeper. The minimum annual assessment is one dollar.

10 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-08-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

11 amended and reenacted as follows:

12 **4.1-08-06.** Assessment - Authorized expenditures.

- 13 The assessment required by this chapter may be used to fund research, <u>including efforts</u>
- 14 that focus on honeybee colony health; education programs; and market development efforts,
- as well as promotional efforts such as the North Dakota honey queen program.
- 16 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-08-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **4.1-08-07. Commissioner Powers**.
- 19 The commissioner may:
- 20 1. Expend moneys appropriated under this chapter for the purposes set forth in section
- 4.1-08-06, provided the commissioner first consults with a committee appointed bythe
- 22 <u>board of directors of</u> the North Dakota beekeepers' association; and
- 2. Do all things necessary and proper to enforce and administer this chapter.

1 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2015, and after that

2 date is ineffective.
