- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 10-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to prohibition of imposition by the securities commissioner of restrictions
- 3 on income or assets of investors or potential investors in real estate investment trusts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Income or asset restriction required to be adopted as rule for investors or potential</u>
- 8 investors in real estate investment trusts.
- 9 The securities commissioner may not establish any restriction on income or assets of
- 10 investors or potential investors in real estate investment trusts unless the restriction is adopted
- 11 as a rule in accordance with chapter 28-32 upon a finding supported by substantial evidence to
- 12 <u>establish that the restriction is in the public interest and in the best interest of investors.</u>
