- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact seven new sections to chapter 15.1-19 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to bullying.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Bullying Definition.
- As used in this Act, bullying means:
- 1. a. Conduct that occurs in a public school, on school district premises, in a district
  owned or leased schoolbus or school vehicle, at a schoolbus stop, or at any
- 10 <u>public school or school district sanctioned or sponsored activity or event; and</u>
- 11 which:
- 12 (1) <u>Is so severe, pervasive, or objectively offensive that it substantially</u>
- 13 <u>interferes with the student's educational opportunities;</u>
- 14 (2) Places the student in actual and reasonable fear of harm;
- 15 (3) Places the student in actual and reasonable fear of damage to property of the student; or
- 17 (4) Substantially disrupts the orderly operation of the public school; or
- b. Conduct that is received by a student while the student is in a public school, on
- 19 <u>school district premises, in a district owned or leased schoolbus or school</u>
- 20 <u>vehicle, at a schoolbus stop, or at any public school or school district sanctioned</u>
- 21 <u>or sponsored activity or event; and which:</u>
- 22 (1) <u>Is so severe, pervasive, or objectively offensive that it substantially</u>

24	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created						
25	and enacted as follows:						
26	Superintendent of public instruction - Bullying prohibition - Development of model						
27	policy.						
28	<u>Befo</u>	Before January 1, 2012, the superintendent of public instruction shall consult with the North					
29	<u>Dakota</u>	Dakota school boards association and the education standards and practices board and:					
30	<u>1.</u>	1. Develop a model policy to prohibit bullying; and					

1 Propose strategies pertaining to the prevention of bullying for incorporation in teacher 2 preservice training courses. 3 SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 4 and enacted as follows: 5 Professional development activities. 6 Each school district shall provide training in the prevention of bullying to its teachers 7 through professional development activities and to all volunteers and nonlicensed personnel 8 who have significant contact with students. 9 SECTION 5. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 10 and enacted as follows: 11 **Bullying prevention programs.** 12 Each school district shall provide bullying prevention programs to all students from 13 kindergarten through grade twelve and shall provide documentation regarding its bullying 14 prevention programs to the superintendent of public instruction, at the time and in the manner 15 directed by the superintendent. 16 SECTION 6. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 17 and enacted as follows: 18 Causes of action - Immunity. 19 This section does not prevent a victim from seeking redress pursuant to any other 1. 20 applicable civil or criminal law. This section does not create or alter any civil cause of 21 action for monetary damages against any person or school district, nor does this 22 section constitute grounds for any claim or motion raised by either the state or a 23 defendant in any proceedings. 24 Any individual who promptly, reasonably, and in good faith reports an incident of 25 bullying, reprisal, or retaliation to the school district employee or official designated in 26 the school district policy is immune from civil or criminal liability resulting from or 27 relating to the report or to the individual's participation in any administrative or judicial 28 proceeding stemming from the report. 29 A school district and its employees are immune from any liability that might otherwise 30 be incurred as a result of a student having been the recipient of bullying, if the school

1 district implemented a bullying policy, as required by section 2 of this Act and 2 substantially complied with that policy. 3 SECTION 7. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 4 and enacted as follows: 5 **Internet safety measures - Policy requirement - Parental notification.** 6 The board of each school district shall develop and implement a policy setting forth internet 7 safety measures designed to protect students from inappropriate subject matter and materials 8 that can be accessed via the internet. The board shall provide a copy of the policy to the parent 9 of each student enrolled in the district.
