- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to variance reports for certain construction projects at institutions of
- 3 higher education.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Construction projects at institutions of higher education Variance reports.
- 8 <u>1.</u> Whenever any new construction, renovation, or repair, valued at more than two
- 9 <u>hundred fifty thousand dollars is underway on the campus of an institution of higher</u>
- education under the control of the state board of higher education, the board shall
- provide monthly project variance reports to the director of the office of management
- 12 <u>and budget. Each report must include:</u>
- 13 <u>a. The name or a description of the project;</u>
- b. The expenditure authorized by the legislative assembly;
- 15 <u>c.</u> The amount of the original contract:
- 16 <u>d. The amount of any change orders;</u>
- e. The amount of any potential or anticipated change orders;
- 18 <u>f. The sum of subdivisions c through e and the amount by which that sum varies</u>
- 19 <u>from the expenditure authorized by the legislative assembly;</u>
- 20 g. The total expended for the project to date; and
- 21 <u>h. The schedule variance by number of days.</u>
- 22 <u>2. The state board of higher education also shall provide to the director of the office of the o</u>
- 23 <u>management and budget, at the same time as the project variance report required by</u>
- 24 subsection 1:

 A list of each public and nonpublic entity that has a contractually reflected
