## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1333**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 11-23-01, 50-03-08, 50-06-20, 50-09-27, and
- 2 50-24.1-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to programs funded at state expense; to
- 3 repeal section 50-09-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to foster care and
- 4 subsidized adoptions costs; to provide for a study of the administration and funding of state and
- 5 county social services programs; and to provide an expiration date.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 11-23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 11-23-01. Officers required to furnish commissioners with departmental budget.
    - 1. Every officer in charge of any institution, office, or undertaking supported wholly or in part by the county shall file with the board of county commissioners a departmental budget that is prescribed by the state auditor. The departmental budget must include an itemized statement of the estimated amount of money that will be required for the maintenance, operation, or improvement of the institution, office, or undertaking for the ensuing year. The board of county commissioners may require additional information to clarify the departmental budget.
    - 2. The departmental budget submitted by the county social service board in 2011 must identify the reduction in county funding derived from transferring foster care subsidized adoption costs pursuant to sections 3, 4, and 6 of this Act and the county's share of medical assistance and other family preservation services pursuant to sections 2 and 5 of this Act from the county social service board to the department of human services beginning August 1, 2011. The amount reported must equal the full amount budgeted for these costs in the budget submitted by the county social service board and approved by the board of county commissioners in 2010. The budget must include a

1 Each county shall reimburse the department of human services the amount required to 2 be appropriated under subsection 3 of section 50-03-08. 3 **SECTION 6. REPEAL.** Section 50-09-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed. 4 SECTION 7. STUDY - ADMINISTRATION AND FUNDING OF STATE AND COUNTY 5 **SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS.** During the 2011-12 interim, the department of human 6 services shall study and develop a plan for restructuring the administration and funding of all 7 state and county social services programs. The plan must provide for the unification of all state 8 and county social services programs into state administered and funded social services 9 programs. Before June 1, 2012, the department shall present its findings, the proposed plan, 10 and any legislative changes necessary to implement that plan to the legislative management. 11 **SECTION 8. EXPIRATION DATE.** Section 1 of this Act is effective through December 31, 12 2011, and after that date is ineffective.
