HB1236 provides that 50% of general funds for vacant positions would be deposited (turned back) to the general fund. It is indeterminable as to how much it would be as it depends on how many positions are left vacant.

HB 1236 potentially eliminates agencies' ability to pay out leave when employees leave/retire. Agencies are not provided funding for leave payouts. About \$2 million of general fund dollars will be paid out in current biennium for annual/sick leave.
