- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-14 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to employer's payment of accrued paid time off.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 34-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Limitations on accrued paid time off Investigation.</u>
- 7 <u>1. If an employee separates from employment voluntarily, a private employer may</u>
 8 <u>withhold payment for accrued paid time off if:</u>
 - a. The employee has been employed by the employer for less than two years; and
 - b. The employee gave the employer less than ten days' written or verbal notice.
- As provided under section 34-14-05, an employee may report a violation under this
 section. If a report of violation is made within thirty days of the alleged violation, the
 labor commissioner shall hold a hearing on the merits of the claim. If a report is made
 more than thirty days following the alleged violation, the commissioner may hold a
- hearing on the merits of the claim.
