ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1397

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-35-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the membership of the legislative management; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-35-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 54-35-01. Legislative management - Created - Members - Vacancy - Terms. 7 The North Dakota legislative management consists of the majority and minority 1. 8 leaders of the house and of the senate plus, the speaker of the house, and six 9 senators and seven six representatives chosen biennially before the close of each 10 regular legislative session. 11 In the house of representatives the speaker of the house majority leader shall appoint 2. 12 to the legislative management four members recommendedelected by the majority-13 leader and three members recommended by political party with the largest number of 14 members in the house and the minority leader of the house shall appoint to the 15 legislative management members elected by the political party with the next largest 16 number of members in the house, except that the speaker must by virtue of office be-17 one of the four members appointed from the speaker's faction political party of the 18 house shall appoint to the legislative management two members elected by the 19 political party with the next largest number of members in the house. 20 3. In the senate the lieutenant governor majority leader shall appoint to the legislative 21 management four members recommendedelected by the majority leader and two-22 members recommended by political party with the largest number of members in the
- 23 <u>senate and the minority leader shall appoint to the legislative management two</u>

1		members elected by the political party with the next largest number of members in the
2	I	senate.
3	<u> <u>4. </u></u>	The majority and minority leaders of the house of representatives shall make the
4		appointments so as to give the two political parties having the most members in the
5		house the same total proportionate representation on the legislative management as
6		prevails in the house. In allocating the membership on the legislative management to

7 each political party, the total number of members in the house of representatives must 8 be divided by nine; the resulting quotient must then be divided into the number of 9 members of each of the two political parties of the house; the resulting quotient for-10 each party of the house, rounded to the nearest whole number, is the number of 11 members of that political party in the house to be on the legislative management. 12 Notwithstanding this allocation, if the number of members in the minority political party 13 in the house of representatives would not result in any representation on the legislative-14 management, the minority leader in the house must represent that party on the 15 legislative management.

- 16 <u>5. A member of the house of representatives may not be appointed to serve as a</u>
 17 <u>member of the legislative management more than twice.</u>
- 18 6.4. Any vacancy occurring when the legislative assembly is not in session must be filled 19 by the selection of another member of the legislative assembly belonging to the same 20 factionparty as the member originally appointed, the selection to be made by the 21 remaining senate or house members of the legislative management, depending upon 22 which body has the vacancy. Each senator and each representative chosen to serve 23 on the legislative management shall serve until a new legislative management has 24 been selected at the next regular legislative session; provided, however, that no 25 senator, not a holdover, who is not reelected to the senate, and no representative, who 26 is not reelected to the house of representatives, may serve as a member of the 27 legislative management beyond the closing day of the term to which elected. Any 28 vacancy occurring because any member of the legislative management is not 29 reelected must be filled for the period from the beginning of the session until a new 30 legislative management is selected, in the same manner as the original legislative 31 management is selected.
