- 1 A BILL for an Act to establish a state heritage foundation; and to provide for reports to the
- 2 budget section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1.

5 State heritage foundation.

- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is established a state heritage foundation.
- 7 The state heritage foundation consists of all property in this state and guarantees all property
- 8 rights of the people of North Dakota guaranteed by the Constitution of North Dakota and the
- 9 <u>Constitution of the United States, and the state heritage foundation designation is superior to</u>
- 10 any contrary or conflicting claim of any federal mandate or law affecting property.

11 SECTION 2. NORTHERN PLAINS HERITAGE FOUNDATION - REPORTS TO BUDGET

12 **SECTION.** The northern plains heritage foundation or any similar entity, heretofore or hereafter

- 13 created, may not infringe on any property right guaranteed to the people of North Dakota by law
- 14 or the Constitution of North Dakota or the Constitution of the United States and must abide by
- 15 all laws enacted by the legislative assembly affecting property. The northern plains heritage

16 foundation or any similar entity shall report periodically as required by the budget section on:

- 17
 - 1. The development of the northern plains national heritage area management plan.
- Each annual report made to the secretary of the interior concerning the northern plains
 national heritage area.
- 20 3. Specific performance goals and accomplishments of the foundation.
- 21 4. The expenses and income of the foundation.
- 5. The amounts and sources of matching funds obtained by the foundation.
- 23 6. The amounts leveraged with federal funds and sources of the leveraged funds.
- 24 7. Grants made to any other entities during the fiscal year.
