1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for a healthy school program grant.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
4 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$660,000, or so much of the
5 sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of awarding a
6 healthy school program grant to a regional education association, for the biennium beginning
7 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

8 1. The grant recipient must be selected by the staff of the heart disease and stroke
9 prevention program in the state department of health and the staff of the North Dakota
10 rural health association.

11 2. Under the direction provided by the staff of the heart disease and stroke prevention
12 program, the grant recipient shall provide to its member school districts and coordinate
13 with the seven other regional education associations in the state so those associations
14 can provide to their member districts the following:

15 a. Activities designed to improve the physical education curricula and the delivery of
16 physical education at the elementary and high school levels;

17 b. Hands on instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to students within the
18 health curriculum;

19 c. Assistance with automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness
20 monitoring; and

21 d. Any other health-related programs identified by the regional education
22 associations and supported by the superintendent of public instruction through
23 the North Dakota coordinated school health program.
