- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-11-02, 4.1-11-03, 4.1-11-04, and 4.1-11-05
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to soybean council elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-11-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 4.1-11-02. Soybean districts Establishment.
- 7 <u>1.</u> The state consists of the following eight soybean districts:
- 8 1. a. Richland County;
- 9 2. b. Dickey, LaMoure, Ransom, and Sargent Counties;
- 10 3. c. Cass County;
- 11 4. d. Barnes, Griggs, and Steele Counties;
- 12 <u>5. e.</u> Traill County;
- 13 6. f. Grand Forks County;
- 14 7. g. Pembina, Nelson, and Walsh Counties; and
- 15 8. h. All other North Dakota counties in which soybeans are grown.
- 16 <u>2. Beginning April 1, 2012, the state consists of the following twelve soybean districts:</u>

 - 5. An elected member of the council may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
- 6. If an individual is appointed to complete a vacancy, that service is not counted as a 5 term for purposes of this section unless the duration of that service exceeds one year.
- 6 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 4.1-11-04. Election of county representative.

- No later than March firstthirty-first of the year in which the term of a council member is to expire, the extension agent for each county in that member's district shall hold a meeting of soybean producers for the purpose of electingconduct an <u>election to select</u> a county representative.
 - b. Before February first, the county extension agent shall forward a letter to each producer residing in the county. The letter must contain a description of the election process, a request for the nomination of potential candidates, and a deadline for the receipt of nominations.
 - The county extension agent shall publish notice of the meeting in the official <u>C.</u> newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The notice must contain a description of the election process, a request for the nomination of potential candidates, and a deadline for the receipt of nominations. The last notice must be published no fewer than five nor more than ten days before the meeting.
 - The meeting must be held within the county. С.
 - During the meeting, the county extension agent shall conduct the election. d.
- Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election. e.
 - f. The deadline for the receipt of nominations.
 - In order for a nomination to be valid, the nomination must be submitted in writing <u>d.</u> and be signed by the nominating producer, who must reside in the county. The county extension agent shall determine if a nomination is valid. A decision by the county extension agent under this subsection is final.

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1 4.1-11-05. Election of council member - District representative.

- Upon receiving the notice that the election has taken place, as required by
 subdivision fh of subsection 1 of section 4.1-11-04, the director of the North Dakota
 state university extension service shall call a meeting of all county representatives in
 the district represented by the member whose term is to expire.
- The director shall notify each county representative in the district of the meeting by registered mail at least five days before the meeting.
 - 3. The meetingAt the discretion of the director of the North Dakota state university

 extension service, the meeting may be held by any means, including by conference

 call or other electronic medium. If the meeting requires physical presence at a

 particular location, that location must be held within the district.
 - 4. At the meeting, the county representatives shall elect one from among themselves to serve as the council member from that district.
 - 5. The director shall notify the governor and the council that the election has taken place and shall provide to the governor and the council the name and address of the newly elected council member.
- 17 6. If the county representatives fail to elect an individual, as required by this section, the
 18 director of the North Dakota state university extension service shall notify the council
 19 and the council shall appoint a producer from the district to serve as the district's
 20 council member. An individual appointed under this subsection has the same rights,
 21 duties, and privileges as an elected council member.
