- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-11-02, 4.1-11-03, 4.1-11-04, and 4.1-11-05
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to soybean council elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **4.1-11-02. Soybean districts - Establishment.**

- 7 <u>1.</u> The state consists of the following eight soybean districts:
- 8 <u>1.</u> Richland County;
- 9 2. <u>b.</u> Dickey, LaMoure, Ransom, and Sargent Counties;
- 10 <u>3.</u> <u>c.</u> Cass County;
- 11 4. <u>d.</u> Barnes, Griggs, and Steele Counties;
- 12 5. <u>e.</u> Traill County;
- 13 6. <u>f.</u> Grand Forks County;
- 14 7. g. Pembina, Nelson, and Walsh Counties; and
- 15 8. <u>h.</u> All other North Dakota counties in which soybeans are grown.
- 16 <u>2.</u> Beginning April 1, 2012, the state consists of the following twelve soybean districts:
- 17 <u>a.</u> <u>District one: Richland County;</u>
- 18 <u>b.</u> <u>District two: Ransom and Sargent Counties;</u>
- 19 <u>c.</u> <u>District three: Dickey and LaMoure Counties;</u>
- 20 <u>d.</u> <u>District four: Cass County:</u>
- 21 <u>e.</u> <u>District five: Barnes County;</u>
- 22 <u>f.</u> <u>District six: Stutsman County;</u>

11	1.	The	cour	ncil consists of one producer elected from each of the eight districts
12		esta	blish	ed in section 4.1-11-02.
13	2.	Eac	h me	mber of the council must be a resident of and a producer in the district that
14		the	mem	ber represents.
15	3.	<u>a.</u>	The	term of each elected member is three years and begins on April first
16			follo	owing the member's election. The Except as otherwise provided in this
17			<u>sub</u> :	section, the terms must be staggered so that no more than three expire each
18			yea	r.
19		<u>b.</u>	Not	withstanding subdivision a, the terms of all council members expire on
20			<u>Mar</u>	ch 31, 2012. Between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012, each district
21			<u>esta</u>	ablished by subsection 2 of section 4.1-11-02 shall elect an individual to serve
22			<u>as a</u>	a council member with a term beginning April 1, 2012. The initial terms of
23			<u>indiv</u>	viduals elected to begin serving as council members on April 1, 2012, are:
24			<u>(1)</u>	One year for council members representing districts one, five, seven, and
25				nine;
26			<u>(2)</u>	Two years for council members representing districts two, eight, ten, and
27				twelve; and
28			<u>(3)</u>	Three years for council members representing districts three, four, six, and
29				eleven.
30	4.	If at	any	time during a member's term the member ceases to possess any of the
31		qua	lificat	ions provided for in this section, the member's office is deemed vacant and

1		the council, by majority vote, shall appoint another qualified producer to serve for the
2		remainder of the term.
3	5.	An elected member of the council may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
4	6.	If an individual is appointed to complete a vacancy, that service is not counted as a
5		term for purposes of this section unless the duration of that service exceeds one year.
6	<u> </u>	TION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7	amende	d and reenacted as follows:
8		11-04. Election of county representative.
9	1.	a. No later than March firstthirty-first of the year in which the term of a council
10		member is to expire, the extension agent for each county in that member's district
11		shall hold a meeting of soybean producers for the purpose of electingconduct an
12		election to select a county representative.
13		b. Before February first, the county extension agent shall forward a letter to each
14		producer residing in the county. The letter must contain a description of the
15		election process, a request for the nomination of potential candidates, and a
16		deadline for the receipt of nominations.
17		<u>c.</u> The county extension agent shall publish notice of the meeting in the official
18		newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The notice must contain a
19		description of the election process, a request for the nomination of potential
20		candidates, and a deadline for the receipt of nominations. The last notice must be
21		published no fewer than five nor more than ten days before the meeting.
22		c. The meeting must be held within the county.
23		d. During the meeting, the county extension agent shall conduct the election.
24		e. Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election.
25		f. The <u>deadline for the receipt of nominations.</u>
26		d. In order for a nomination to be valid, the nomination must be submitted in writing
27		and be signed by the nominating producer, who must reside in the county. The
28		county extension agent shall determine if a nomination is valid. A decision by the
29		county extension agent under this subsection is final.
30		e. The county extension agent shall:
31		(1) Compile all valid nominations;

1	(2) Contact each nominee to determine if the nominee consents to being on the
2	ballot;
3	<u>(3)</u> Prepare the ballot; and
4	(4) Before March first, mail to each producer in the county the ballot,
5	instructions for completing and returning the ballot, and notice of the
6	deadline by which the ballot must be returned.
7	<u>f.</u> <u>The county extension agent shall publish notice of the pending election in the</u>
8	official newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The notice must announce
9	the election, provide information regarding the manner in which a producer may obtain
10	a ballot, and indicate the deadline by which all ballots must be returned. The last
11	notice must be published no fewer than ten days before the deadline by which the
12	ballots must be returned.
13	g. Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election.
14	h. Immediately after the passing of the deadline by which the ballots must be
15	returned, the county extension agent shall canvass the votestabulate the ballots,
16	notify the director of the North Dakota state university extension service and the

29	reenacted as follows:

1	4.1-	11-04. Election of county representative.
2	1.	a. No later than March first of the year in which the term of a council member is to-
3		expire, the extension agent for each county in that member's district shall hold a
4		meeting of soybean producers for the purpose of electing a county
5		representative.
6		b. The county extension agent shall publish notice of the meeting in the official
7		newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The last notice must be
8		published no fewer than five nor more than ten days before the meeting.
9		c. The meeting must be held within the county.
10		d. During the meeting, the county extension agent shall conduct the election.
11		e. Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election.
12		f. The county extension agent shall canvass the votes, notify the director of the
13		North Dakota state university extension service and the council that the election
14		has taken place, and provide to the director and the council the name and
15		address of the newly elected county representative.
16	2.	Subsection 1 does not apply if the county extension agent, in consultation with the
17		executive director of the county farm service agency office, determines and notifies the
18		council that no soybean producers willing to serve as county representatives reside-
19		within the county.
20	1.	Before January first, the council shall identify each district represented by a council
21		member whose term is about to expire and notify the extension agent for each county
22		in that member's district that an election to select a county representative must occur
23		before March first.
24	2.	Each year during the month of January, each county extension agent required to
25		conduct an election in accordance with this section shall publish notice of the election
26		in the official newspaper of the county for one week. The notice must contain a
27		description of the election process, a request for the nomination of potential
28		candidates for the position, and a deadline for the receipt of all nominations.
29	3.	In order for a nomination to be valid, it must be submitted to the county extension
30		agent in writing and signed by a nominating producer who resides in the county. The

	county extension agent shall determine if a nomination is valid. A decision by the
	county extension agent under this subsection is final.
4.	The county extension agent shall:
	a. Compile all valid nominations;
	b. Contact each nominee to determine if the nominee consents to being on the
	ballot; and
	c. Forward the name of each nominee to the council.
5.	The council shall prepare the election ballots and mail to each producer of record in
	the county:
	a. A ballot;
	b. A stamped self-addressed return envelope;
	c. Instructions for completing and returning the ballot; and
	d. A statement indicating the last date by which the ballots must be postmarked or
	filed with the county extension agent.
6.	The county extension agent shall publish notice of the pending election in the official
	newspaper of the county for one week. The notice must announce the election,
	provide information regarding the manner in which a producer may obtain a ballot if
	one was not received by mail, and indicate the deadline by which all ballots must be
	returned.
7.	Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election.
8.	Immediately after the passing of the deadline by which the ballots must be returned,
	the county extension agent shall:
	a. Tabulate the ballots;
	b. Notify the director of the North Dakota state university extension service and the
	council that the election has taken place and provide to the director and the
	council the name and address of the newly elected county representative; and
	c. Notify the newly elected county representative.
9.	Subsections 1 through 8 do not apply if the county extension agent, in consultation
	with the executive director of the county farm service agency office, determines and
	notifies the council that no soybean producers willing to serve as county
	representatives reside within the county.

1	SEC	TION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is				
2	amended and reenacted as follows:					
3	4.1-11-05. Election of council member - District representative.					
4	1.	Upon receiving the notice that the election has taken place, as required by				
5		subdivision fh of subsection 1 of section 4.1-11-04, the director of the North Dakota				
6		state university extension service shall call a meeting of all county representatives in				
7		the district represented by the member whose term is to expire.				
8	2.	The director shall notify each county representative in the district of the meeting by				
9		registered mail at least five days before the meeting.				
10	3.	The meetingAt the discretion of the director of the North Dakota state university				
11		extension service, the meeting may be held by any means, including by conference				
12		call or other electronic medium. If the meeting requires physical presence at a				
13		particular location, that location must be held within the district.				
14	4.	At the meeting, the county representatives shall elect one from among themselves to				
15		serve as the council member from that district.				
16	5.	The director shall notify the governor and the council that the election has taken place				
17		and shall provide to the governor and the council the name and address of the newly				
18		elected council member.				
19	<u>6.</u>	If the county representatives fail to elect an individual, as required by this section, the				
20		director of the North Dakota state university extension service shall notify the council				
21		and the council shall appoint a producer from the district to serve as the district's				
22		council member. An individual appointed under this subsection has the same rights,				
23		duties, and privileges as an elected council member.
