- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4.1-11-02, 4.1-11-03, 4.1-11-04, and 4.1-11-05
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to soybean council elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-11-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 4.1-11-02. Soybean districts Establishment.
- 7 <u>1.</u> The state consists of the following eight soybean districts:
- 8 1. a. Richland County;
- 9 2. b. Dickey, LaMoure, Ransom, and Sargent Counties;
- 10 3. c. Cass County;
- 11 4. d. Barnes, Griggs, and Steele Counties;
- 12 <u>5. e.</u> Traill County;
- 13 6. f. Grand Forks County;
- 14 7. g. Pembina, Nelson, and Walsh Counties; and
- 15 8. h. All other North Dakota counties in which soybeans are grown.
- 16 <u>2. Beginning April 1, 2012, the state consists of the following twelve soybean districts:</u>
- 17 a. District one: Richland County;
- 18 <u>b.</u> <u>District two: Ransom and Sargent Counties;</u>
- 19 <u>c.</u> <u>District three: Dickey and LaMoure Counties;</u>
- d. <u>District four: Cass County;</u>
- 21 <u>e. District five: Barnes County;</u>
- 22 <u>f. District six: Stutsman County;</u>
- 23 g. District seven: Grand Forks and Traill Counties;
- 24 <u>h. District eight: Griggs, Nelson, and Steele Counties;</u>

1 the council, by majority vote, shall appoint another qualified producer to serve for the 2 remainder of the term. 3 5. An elected member of the council may not serve more than two consecutive terms. 4 6. If an individual is appointed to complete a vacancy, that service is not counted as a 5 term for purposes of this section unless the duration of that service exceeds one year. 6 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows: 8 4.1-11-04. Election of county representative. 9 No later than March first of the year in which the term of a council member is to-10 expire, the extension agent for each county in that member's district shall hold a-11 meeting of soybean producers for the purpose of electing a county-12 representative. 13 The county extension agent shall publish notice of the meeting in the official-b. 14 newspaper of the county for two consecutive weeks. The last notice must be 15 published no fewer than five nor more than ten days before the meeting. 16 The meeting must be held within the county. C. 17 d. During the meeting, the county extension agent shall conduct the election. 18 e. Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election. 19 f. The county extension agent shall canvass the votes, notify the director of the 20 North Dakota state university extension service and the council that the election-21 has taken place, and provide to the director and the council the name and 22 address of the newly elected county representative. 23 2. Subsection 1 does not apply if the county extension agent, in consultation with the 24 executive director of the county farm service agency office, determines and notifies the 25 council that no soybean producers willing to serve as county representatives reside-26 within the county. 27 <u>1.</u> Before January first, the council shall identify each district represented by a council 28 member whose term is about to expire and notify the extension agent for each county

in that member's district that an election to select a county representative must occur

1 Each year during the month of January, each county extension agent required to 2 conduct an election in accordance with this section shall publish notice of the election 3 in the official newspaper of the county for one week. The notice must contain a 4 description of the election process, a request for the nomination of potential 5 candidates for the position, and a deadline for the receipt of all nominations. 6 <u>3.</u> In order for a nomination to be valid, it must be submitted to the county extension 7 agent in writing and signed by a nominating producer who resides in the county. The 8 county extension agent shall determine if a nomination is valid. A decision by the 9 county extension agent under this subsection is final. 10 The county extension agent shall: 11 Compile all valid nominations; a. 12 <u>b.</u> Contact each nominee to determine if the nominee consents to being on the 13 ballot; and 14 Forward the name of each nominee to the council. 15 <u>5.</u> The council shall prepare the election ballots and mail to each producer of record in 16 the county: 17 A ballot; <u>a.</u> 18 <u>b.</u> A stamped self-addressed return envelope; 19 Instructions for completing and returning the ballot; and <u>C.</u> 20 A statement indicating the last date by which the ballots must be postmarked or <u>d.</u> 21 filed with the county extension agent. 22 The county extension agent shall publish notice of the pending election in the official 6. 23 newspaper of the county for one week. The notice must announce the election. 24 provide information regarding the manner in which a producer may obtain a ballot if 25 one was not received by mail, and indicate the deadline by which all ballots must be 26 returned. 27 <u>7.</u> Any producer who resides in the county may vote in the election. 28 8. Immediately after the passing of the deadline by which the ballots must be returned, 29 the county extension agent shall: 30 Tabulate the ballots; <u>a.</u>

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1 Notify the director of the North Dakota state university extension service and the 2 council that the election has taken place and provide to the director and the 3 council the name and address of the newly elected county representative; and 4 Notify the newly elected county representative. C. 5 <u>9.</u> Subsections 1 through 8 do not apply if the county extension agent, in consultation 6 with the executive director of the county farm service agency office, determines and 7 notifies the council that no soybean producers willing to serve as county 8 representatives reside within the county. 9 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 10 amended and reenacted as follows: 11 4.1-11-05. Election of council member - District representative. 12 Upon receiving the notice that the election has taken place, as required by 13 subdivision fh of subsection 1 of section 4.1-11-04, the director of the North Dakota 14 state university extension service shall call a meeting of all county representatives in 15 the district represented by the member whose term is to expire. 16 2. The director shall notify each county representative in the district of the meeting by 17 registered mail at least five days before the meeting. 18 3. The meetingAt the discretion of the director of the North Dakota state university 19 extension service, the meeting may be held by any means, including by conference 20 call or other electronic medium. If the meeting requires physical presence at a 21 particular location, that location must be held within the district. 22 4. At the meeting, the county representatives shall elect one from among themselves to 23 serve as the council member from that district. 24 5. The director shall notify the governor and the council that the election has taken place and shall provide to the governor and the council the name and address of the newly 25 26 elected council member. 27 <u>6.</u> If the county representatives fail to elect an individual, as required by this section, the 28 director of the North Dakota state university extension service shall notify the council 29 and the council shall appoint a producer from the district to serve as the district's 30 council member. An individual appointed under this subsection has the same rights,

duties, and privileges as an elected council member.

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
