- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-08.1-03.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to contribution and expenditure statements filed by persons sponsoring the
- 3 circulation of initiated measure petitions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 16.1-08.1-03.1. Contributions statement required of persons and measure committees
 8 circulating or promoting passage or defeat of initiated or referred measure.

- 9 Any The sponsoring committee for an initiated measure petition and any person or 1. 10 measure committee, as described in section 16.1-08.1-01, who that is soliciting or 11 accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding or opposing the circulation or 12 passage of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or measure placed upon a 13 statewide ballot by action of the legislative assembly at any election shall file a 14 statement in accordance with this section subsection if the person has received any 15 contributions from a personcontribution in excess of one hundred dollars. The 16 statement must include the name and mailing address of all contributors whoeach 17 person that contributed in excess of one hundred dollars to the person, the amount of 18 each reportable contribution, and the date each reportable contribution was received. 19 The statement must include the name and mailing address of each recipient of an 20 expenditure exceeding one hundred dollars in the aggregate, the amount of each 21 reportable expenditure, and the date the expenditure was made. 22 2. 1 petition or measure placed upon a statewide ballot by action of the legislative 2 assembly may not accept a contribution of more than one hundred dollars from a-3 person who does not reside in this state or from an out-of-state person or political 4 committee unless the contribution is accompanied by a certified statement from the 5 contributor listing the name, address, and amount contributed by each person whothat 6 contributed more than one hundred dollars of the contribution. The statement must 7 indicate if no individual person contributed in excess of one hundred dollars of the 8 out-of-state person's or political committee's overall contribution. The certified 9 statement must also list the occupation, employer, and principal place of business for 10 each personindividual who contributed more than one hundred dollars of the 11 contribution. The chairman of the sponsoring committee of an initiated measure 12 petition and person soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding the 13 circulation of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or of promoting passage or 14 defeat of a statewide initiated or referred measure must shall include this statement 15 with the contribution statement required to be filed under subsection 1. 16 3. The sponsoring committee of an initiated measure petition shall file quarterly 17 statements during the period the measure is being circulated, which statements must 18 be filed with the secretary of state no later than the twelfth day after the end of each 19 guarter during which the petition is being circulated. The statement required of a 20 person or measure committee under subsection 1 must be filed with the secretary of 21 state no later than the twelfth day prior tobefore the date of the election in which the

22 measure appears or would have appeared on the ballot complete from the beginning 23 of that calendar year through the twentieth day prior tobefore the date of the election. 24 A complete statement for the entire calendar year for each statement required to be 25 filed under this section must be filed no later than the thirty-first day of January of the 26 following year. Even if a person required to report according to this section has not 27 received any contributions in excess of one hundred dollars during the reporting 28 period, the person shall file a statement as required by this chapter. A statement filed 29 according to this section during the reporting period must show the following:

30 a. The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made in excess of
31 one hundred dollars;

- 1 b. The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made of one
- 2 hundred dollars, or less; and
- 3 c. The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting
 4 period.
