- 7 1. The following statewide codes are exempt from this chapter:
  - a. The Standards for Electrical Wiring and Equipment, as contained in North Dakota
    Administrative Code article 24-02.
    - The State Plumbing Code, as contained in North Dakota Administrative Code article 62-03.
  - The State Fire Code, as contained in the rules of the state fire marshal as provided in section 18-01-04.
- 14 2. The following buildings are exempt from this chapter:
  - a. Buildings which are neither heated nor cooled.
- b. Buildings used whose peak design rate of energy usage is less than one watt persquare foot [929.0304 square centimeters] or three and four-tenths British
  thermal units an hour per square foot [929.0304 square centimeters] of floor
  area.
  - e. Restored or reconstructed buildings building deliberately preserved beyond their that building's normal term of use because of historical associations, architectural interests, or public policy, or buildings building otherwise qualified as a pioneer building, historical site, state monument, or other similar designation pursuant tounder state or local law is exempt from this chapter.
