- 2 Century Code, relating to the property tax exemption for church property; and to provide an

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 9 of section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 All real property, not exceeding twotwenty acres [.81 hectare][8.09 hectares] in extent, 9. 8 that does not produce any revenue which is owned by a religious corporation or-9 organization and all real property owned by any religious corporation or organization. 10 upon which there is a building used for the religious services of the organization, or 11 upon which there is a dwelling with usual outbuildings, intended and ordinarily used for 12 the residence of the bishop, priest, rector, or other minister in charge of services, must 13 be deemed to be property used exclusively for religious services, and exempt from 14 taxation, whether the real property consists of one tract or more. The exemption for a 15 building used for the religious services of the owner continues to be in effect if the 16 building in whole, or in part, is rented to another otherwise tax-exempt corporation or 17 organization, provided no profit is realized from the rent. All real property owned by 18 any religious corporation or organization and used as a parking lot by persons 19 attending religious services is exempt from taxation. All taxes assessed or levied on 20 any of the property, while the property is used for religious purposes, are void. 21 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after 22 December 31, 2010.
