- 2 Century Code, relating to the property tax exemption for church property; and to provide an

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 9 of section 57-02-08 of the North Dakota Century
  Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - All real property, not exceeding twotwenty acres [.81 hectare] [8.09 hectares] in extent, owned by any religious corporation or organization, upon which there is a building used for the religious services of the organization, or upon which there is a dwelling with usual outbuildings, intended and ordinarily used for the residence of the bishop, priest, rector, or other minister in charge of services, must be deemed to be property used exclusively for religious services, and exempt from taxation, whether the real property consists of one tract or more. The exemption for a building used for the religious services of the owner continues to be in effect if the building in whole, or in part, is rented to another otherwise tax-exempt corporation or organization, provided no profit is realized from the rent. All real property owned by any religious corporation or organization and used as a parking lot by persons attending religious services is exempt from taxation. All taxes assessed or levied on any of the property, while the property is used for religious purposes, are void.
  - **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2010.
