1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 64-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the calibration of instruments used to measure grain protein.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 64-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **64-02-01. Definitions.**

7 In this title:

- 8 1. "Calibrate" means to compare a standard, or weighing or measuring device, to another
9 standard and eliminate by adjustment any variation in the accuracy of the item being
10 compared, but does not include the field repair of a weighing or measuring device.
- 11 2. "Commission" means the public service commission.
- 12 3. "Test" means to measure to determine if a standard or weighing or measuring device
13 is within the permitted tolerance.
- 14 4. "Transient vendor" means a wholesale or retail seller of produce, fruit, nuts, or seafood
15 that sells to the public at a temporary location, on a seasonal basis, open less than
16 one hundred twenty business days each year.
- 17 5. "Weighing or measuring device" means any scale, weight, measure, instrument, or
18 device used or offered for use for weighing or measuring in commerce, including any
19 instrument used at a public warehouse or facility to measure the protein content of
20 grain.
