1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 11-11.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to compensation of members of county job development authority boards of directors.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-11.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 11-11.1-02. Members of the job development authority board of directors - Term of
7 office - Oath - Expenses <u>and compensation</u>.

8 The members of the job development authority board of directors and the joint job 9 development authority board of directors shall serve for a term of three years or until their 10 successors are duly gualified. Terms of office begin on January first and must be arranged so 11 that the terms of office of approximately one-third of the members expire on December 12 thirty-first of each year. Each member of the board shall qualify by taking the oath provided for 13 civil officers. The oath must be filed with the county auditor. 14 The board of directors shall annually elect members to serve as chairman, vice chairman, 15 secretary, and treasurer. The board shall also select an executive committee with such powers 16 and duties as may be delegated by the board. Members may be reimbursed from funds 17 available to the authority for mileage and expenses as provided in sections 44-08-04 and 18 54-06-09 butand may not receive compensation for serviceattendance at meetings in an 19 amount as determined by the board of county commissioners.
