- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-05, subsections 12 and 13 of section
- 2 39-06.1-06, section 39-06.1-09, subsection 3 of section 39-06.1-10, and sections 39-09-02 and
- 3 39-10-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the penalty for driving on a closed
- 4 road, in a construction zone, and in a school zone; and to provide a penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **39-06.1-05. Offenses excepted.**

- 9 The procedures authorized under sections 39-06.1-02 and 39-06.1-03 may not be utilized
- 10 by a person charged with one of the following offenses:
- 1. Driving or being in actual physical control of a vehicle in violation of section 39-08-01,
- 12 or an equivalent ordinance.
- Reckless driving or aggravated reckless driving in violation of section 39-08-03, or an
 equivalent ordinance.
- 15 3. A violation of chapter 12.1-16 resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle.
- Leaving the scene of an accident in violation of section 39-08-04, 39-08-05, 39-08-07,
 or 39-08-08, or equivalent ordinances.
- 18 5. Driving while license or driving privilege is suspended or revoked in violation of section
 39-06-42, or an equivalent ordinance.
- 20 6. Violating subdivision b or c of subsection 5 of section 39-24-09.
- 21 7. Operating a modified motor vehicle in violation of section 39-21-45.1.
- 22 8. Driving without liability insurance in violation of section 39-08-20.
- 9. Operating an unsafe vehicle in violation of subsection 2 of section 39-21-46.

- Causing an accident with an authorized emergency vehicle or a vehicle operated by or
 under the control of the director used for maintaining the state highway system in
 violation of subsection 5 of section 39-10-26.
- 4 <u>11.</u> <u>Knowingly entering a closed road under section 39-10-21.1.</u>
- 5 <u>12.</u> Driving in excess of twenty miles per hour over a speed limit in a school zone or
 6 construction zone in violation of subdivision b of subsection 1 or subsection 2 of
 7 section 39-09-02.

8 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsections 12 and 13 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North
9 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

- 10 12. For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of 11 section 39-09-02, or, notwithstanding subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 or section 12 40-05.1-06, of an ordinance in a city or home rule city for a violation of a speed limit 13 dependent upon being on or near a school, fees for a noncriminal disposition are forty 14 dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the posted speed; and forty dollars. 15 plus one dollar for each additional mile per hour over ten miles per hour over the limit 16 unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section to twenty miles per hour 17 over the limit.
- 1813.For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of19section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the20posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles21per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section to22twenty miles per hour over the limit. The fee in this subsection does not apply to a23highway construction zone unless individuals engaged in construction are present at24the time and place of the violation and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum
- 25 Fee \$80".

4			meters] and in traversing an intersection of highways when the driver's view is
5			obstructed. A driver's view is deemed to be obstructed when at any time during
6			the last fifty feet [15.24 meters] of the driver's approach to such intersection, the
7			driver does not have a clear and uninterrupted view of such intersection and of
8			the traffic upon all of the highways entering such intersection for a distance of two
9			hundred feet [60.96 meters] from such intersection.
10		d.	Twenty miles [32.19 kilometers] an hour when the driver's view of the highway
11			ahead is obstructed within a distance of one hundred feet [30.48 meters].
12		e.	Twenty-five miles [40.23 kilometers] an hour on any highway in a business district
13			or in a residence district or in a public park, unless a different speed is designated
14			and posted by local authorities.
15		f.	Fifty-five miles [88.51 kilometers] an hour on gravel, dirt, or loose surface
16			highways, and on paved two-lane county and township highways if there is no
17			speed limit posted, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by
18			conditions.
19		g.	Sixty-five miles [104.61 kilometers] an hour on paved two-lane highways if posted
20			for that speed, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.
21		h.	Seventy miles [112.65 kilometers] an hour on paved and divided multilane
22			highways, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.
23		i.	Seventy-five miles [120.70 kilometers] an hour on access-controlled, paved and
24			divided, multilane interstate highways, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or
25			required by conditions.
26	2.	The	director may designate and post special areas of state highways where lower
27		spee	ed limits apply. Differing limits may be established for different times of the day
28		with	in highway construction zones which are effective when posted upon appropriate
29		fixed	or variable speed limit signs. Driving in excess of twenty miles [32.19 kilometers]
30		<u>per l</u>	hour over the posted speed limit in this section is an infraction if individuals are

1		engaged in construction and are present at the time and place of the violation and the
2		speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".
3	3.	Except as provided by law, it is unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon a
4		highway at a speed that is unsafe or at a speed exceeding the speed limit prescribed
5		by law or established pursuant to law.
6	4.	In charging a violation of the provisions of this section, the complaint must specify the
7		speed at which the defendant is alleged to have driven and the speed which this
8		section prescribes is prima facie lawful at the time and place of the alleged offense.
9	SEC	CTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 39-10-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
10	amende	ed and reenacted as follows:
11	39-′	10-21.1. Closing road because of hazardous conditions - Posting of official
12	traffic-o	control devices - Entering closed road prohibited <u>- Penalty</u> .
13	<u>1.</u>	The highway patrol or local law enforcement authorities having jurisdiction over a road
14		may close a road temporarily due to hazardous conditions for the protection and safety
15		of the public. If such a closing is made, the authority ordering the closing shall make
16		every reasonable attempt to notify the public and, when practical, may post
17		appropriate official traffic-control devices to advise motorists of the closing. No person,
18		while operating
19	<u>2.</u>	An operator of a motor vehicle, may not knowingly enter a road closed under this
20		section.
21	<u>3.</u>	An operator who violates this section is guilty of an infraction.
