- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-13 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the approval of theological studies instructors; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to theological studies
- 4 courses.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 Approval of theological studies instructors.
- 9 The board shall approve an individual to be an instructor of theological studies if the
- 10 <u>individual:</u>
- 11 <u>1. Holds a baccalaureate degree; and</u>
- 12 <u>2. Is recommended for approval as an instructor of theological studies by the governing</u>
- board of a nonpublic school offering a theological studies course.
- 14 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 16 **15.1-21-02.1.** High school graduation Diploma requirements.
- 17 Except as provided in section 15.1-21-02.3, before a school district, a nonpublic high
- school, or the center for distance education issues a high school diploma to a student, the
- 19 student must have successfully completed the following twenty-two units of high school
- 20 coursework:
- 21 1. Four units of English language arts from a sequence that includes literature,
- composition, and speech;
- 23 2. Three units of mathematics;
- 24 3. Three units of science, including:

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1 One unit of physical science; a. 2 One unit of biology; and b. 3 C. (1) One unit of any other science; or 4 Two one-half units of any other science; (2) 5 Three units of social studies, including: 4. 6 a. One unit of United States history; 7 One-half unit of United States government and one-half unit of economics; b. 8 or 9 (2) One unit of problems of democracy; and 10 One unit or two one-half units of any other social studies, which may include 11 civics, civilization, geography and history, multicultural studies, North Dakota 12 studies, psychology, sociology, and world history; 13 5. One unit of physical education; or a. 14 One-half unit of physical education and one-half unit of health; b. 15 Three units of: 6. 16 Foreign languages; a. 17 Native American languages; b. 18 C. Fine arts; or 19 Career and technical education courses; and 20 7. Any five additional units, two of which may be theological studies if taught in a 21 nonpublic school by an approved theological studies instructor.
