## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-20.1-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **15-20.1-22. Grants for innovation.**
- The department shall design and implement a program to provide a dollar-for-dollarmatch to elementary or secondary teachers or schools and to institutions of highereducation for the purpose of provide grants to eligible recipients for the funding
  innovative science, technology, or innovation of:
  - a. Science projects or programs for students in;

- 13 <u>c. Innovation programs for kindergarten through grade twelve. The department shall-</u>
  14 <u>award the grants on a competitive basis, elementary, or high school students.</u>

   or an institution of higher education.
