state.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general 5 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of the 6 sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing 7 grants to federally designated head start programs in this state, for the biennium beginning 8 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. Any amount provided to the department of human 9 services under this section is contingent upon the department demonstrating that a matching 10 amount has been received through gifts, grants, or donations, from nonstate sources for the 11 purposes of this Act. 12 1. The head start state collaboration administrator shall award grants under this section 13 based on an application and criteria that include: 14 a. The number of low-income or at-risk children and families that a program can 15 serve: 16 A program's design, service area, and accessibility to eligible children and b. 17 families: 18 A program's coordination and interaction with licensed child care programs and C. 19 public and nonpublic schools; and 20 d. Proposals for innovative ways of addressing identified needs of eligible children 21 and families. 22 2. In order to be eligible for a grant under this section, a head start unit must be in 23 compliance with all head start performance standards.

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- 1 3. The department shall monitor and provide oversight of grant recipients in conjunction
- 2 with federal head start triennial monitoring.
