- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-51.1-07.3 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the oil and gas research fund; to repeal sections 57-51.1-07.2 and
- 3 57-51.1-07.4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to elimination of the permanent oil tax
- 4 trust fund; to provide for a transfer; and to provide an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-51.1-07.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 57-51.1-07.3. Oil and gas research fund Deposits Continuing appropriation.
- 9 There is established a special fund in the state treasury to be known as the oil and gas
- 10 research fund. Before depositing oil and gas gross production tax and oil extraction tax
- 11 revenues in the general fund or the permanent oil tax trust fund, two percent of the revenues
- must be deposited monthly into the oil and gas research fund, up to four million dollars per
- 13 biennium. All moneys deposited in the oil and gas research fund and interest on all such
- 14 moneys are appropriated as a continuing appropriation to the council to be used for purposes
- 15 stated in chapter 54-17.6.
- 16 SECTION 2. REPEAL. Sections 57-51.1-07.2 and 57-51.1-07.4 of the North Dakota
- 17 Century Code are repealed.
- 18 **SECTION 3. TRANSFER.** On August 1, 2011, the state treasurer shall transfer any
- remaining balance in the permanent oil tax trust fund to the state general fund.
- **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective August 1, 2011.
