1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for the control of Johne's disease.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
4 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$275,000, or so much of the
5 sum as may be necessary, to the agriculture commissioner to aid in controlling Johne's disease
6 in this state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. The
7 commissioner may award grants to livestock producers who participate in the North Dakota
8 voluntary Johne's disease herd status program in order to defray expenses incurred by the
9 producers in testing and controlling Johne's disease and may provide information to producers
10 and veterinarians about efforts to control Johne's disease.
