3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

North Dakota teacher of the year award - Selection - Announcement.

- Annually, the superintendent of public instruction shall accept nominations for the
 North Dakota teacher of the year award.
 - 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall develop and publish the criteria by which all nominees must be considered and shall appoint an eight-member a committee to review the nominations and select the North Dakota teacher of the year. The committee must consist of:
 - a. A former North Dakota teacher of the year award recipient;
 - b. A representative of the North Dakota council of educational leaders;
- 15 <u>c. A representative of the North Dakota department of career and technical</u>
 16 <u>education;</u>
 - d. A representative of the North Dakota department of public instruction;
 - e. A representative of the North Dakota education association;
 - f. A representative of the North Dakota home school association;
 - g.f. A representative of the North Dakota school boards association; and
 - h.q. A representative of nonpublic schools in this state.
 - 3. During September of each year, the superintendent of public instruction shall host in the memorial hall of the state capitol a ceremony at which the award recipient is announced.
