2 Century Code, relating to the North Dakota teacher of the year award.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows:

North Dakota teacher of the year award - Selection - Announcement.

- 7 Annually, the superintendent of public instruction shall accept nominations for the 8 North Dakota teacher of the year award.
- The superintendent of public instruction shall develop and publish the criteria by which 2. 10 all nominees must be considered and shall appoint an eight-member committee to review the nominations and select the North Dakota teacher of the year. The committee must consist of:
 - <u>a.</u> A former North Dakota teacher of the year award recipient;
 - b. A representative of the North Dakota council of educational leaders;
- 15 A representative of the North Dakota department of career and technical <u>C.</u> 16 education:
 - A representative of the North Dakota department of public instruction; d.
 - A representative of the North Dakota education association; <u>e.</u>
 - A representative of the North Dakota home school association;
 - g.f. A representative of the North Dakota school boards association; and
 - A representative of nonpublic schools in this state. <u>h.g.</u>
 - During September of each year, the superintendent of public instruction shall host in the memorial hall of the state capitol a ceremony at which the award recipient is announced.

1	3.	By September thirtieth of each year, the governor and the superintendent of public
2		instruction shall jointly announce the award recipient and serve as the exclusive hosts
3		of a ceremony and reception honoring the teacher of the year. The ceremony and
4		reception must take place in the memorial hall of the state capitol or, if requested by
5		the award recipient, at a location in the municipality within which the recipient resides
6		<u>or works.</u>
