- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the North Dakota teacher of the year award.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 North Dakota teacher of the year award Selection Announcement.
- Annually, the superintendent of public instruction shall accept nominations for the
   North Dakota teacher of the year award.
- 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall develop and publish the criteria by which
   all nominees must be considered and shall appoint an eight-member committee to
   review the nominations and select the North Dakota teacher of the year. The
- 12 <u>committee must consist of:</u>
- 13 <u>a.</u> <u>A former North Dakota teacher of the year award recipient;</u>
- b. <u>A representative of the North Dakota council of educational leaders:</u>
- 15 <u>c. A representative of the North Dakota department of career and technical</u>
   16 <u>education;</u>
- 17 <u>d. A representative of the North Dakota department of public instruction;</u>
- 18 <u>e. A representative of the North Dakota education association;</u>
- 19 <u>f. A representative of the North Dakota school boards association; and</u>
- 20 <u>g. A representative of nonpublic schools in this state.</u>
- 21 <u>3. By September thirtieth of each year, the governor and the superintendent of public</u>
- 22 <u>instruction shall jointly announce the award recipient and serve as the exclusive hosts</u>
- of a ceremony and reception honoring the teacher of the year. The ceremony and
- 24 reception must take place in the memorial hall of the state capitol or, if requested by

- 1 the award recipient, at a location in the municipality within which the recipient resides
- 2 <u>or works.</u>
