- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact four new sections to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the North Dakota commission on higher education
- 3 funding; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows: 7 North Dakota commission on higher education funding - Membership. 8 The North Dakota commission on higher education funding consists of: 9 1. The governor or an individual designated by the governor, who shall serve as the 10 chairman; 11 b. The commissioner of higher education; 12 Two members of the state board of higher education, selected by the state board; <u>C.</u> 13 The vice president for finance and administration at North Dakota state university 14 or the vice president's designee; 15 The vice president for finance and operations at the university of North Dakota or 16
 - the vice president's designee;
 - One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business manager or the vice president for finance at a two-year institution under the control of the state board of higher education;
 - One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business manager or the vice president for finance at any institution under the control of the state board of higher education other than an institution represented undersubdivision d, e, or f;
 - The chairman of the senate education committee or the chairman's designee: h.d.

19	<u>a.e.</u>	One individual appointed by the chairman of the legislative management from a		
20		list of three names submitted by the North Dakota council of college faculties;		
21	f.	One individual appointed by the chairman of the legislative management from a		
22		list of three names submitted by the North Dakota university system staff senate;		
23		<u>and</u>		
24	<u>b.g.</u>	One individual appointed by the chairman of the legislative management from a		
25		list of three names submitted by the North Dakota student association.		
26	SECTIO	N 2. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
27	and enacted as follows:

29	procedure.			
30	<u>1.</u> The	e North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall establish its own		
31	dut	ies and rules of operation and procedure, including rules relating to appointments.		

1		terms of office, vacancies, quorums, and meetings, provided that the duties and the		
2		rules do not conflict with this Act.		
3	<u>2.</u>	Notwithstanding subsection 1, in order for a motion to be adopted by the commission,		
4		other than a motion pertaining solely to procedural matters:		
5		a. The motion must be consented to by any sevensix of the thirteen eleven		
6	1	commission members; and		
7		b. ThreeFour of the fiveseven legislators serving on the commission must be on the		
8		prevailing side.		
9	SEC	TION 3. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
10	and ena	and enacted as follows:		
11	Nor	North Dakota commission on higher education funding - Compensation and		
12	reimbur	sement.		
13	<u>1.</u>	Members of the North Dakota commission on higher education funding are entitled to		
14		reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the same manner as		
15		state officials.		
16	<u>2.</u>	In addition, members of the legislative assembly who serve on the commission and		
17		the individual who is the owner or manager of a business located in this state are		
18		entitled to receive per diem compensation, in the amount provided for in section		
19		54-03-20, if they are attending meetings or performing duties directed by the		
20		commission.		
21	<u>3.</u>	The commissioner of higher education shall use up to forty thousand dollars from		
22		moneys appropriated in the system governance line item in the appropriation bill for		
23		the North Dakota university system office, as approved by the legislative assembly, to		
24		provide the compensation and reimbursements required by this section.		
25	SEC	TION 4. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
26	and enacted as follows:			
27	North Dakota commission on higher education funding - Duties - Reports.			
28	<u>1.</u>	In order to ensure the continued delivery and financing of a quality system of higher		
29		education in this state, the North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall		
30		examine alternative methods for funding higher education, including any funding		

1		method that is developed by the state board of higher education or others and which		
2		will reward:		
3		<u>a.</u>	Specifically identified outcomes such as:	
4			(1) Increases in the number of degrees awarded;	
5			(2) Increases in the number of on-time graduations;	
6			(3) The number of degrees awarded to low-income students; and	
7			(4) Increases in the number of students retained beyond their first year; and	
8		<u>b.</u>	Any other outcome considered desirable by the commission.	
9	<u>2.</u>	The	North Dakota commission on higher education funding may:	
10		<u>a.</u>	Examine a funding methodology that is based on the actual cost of delivering a	
11			quality education to the various cost categories of enrolled students, as	
12			determined by the commission, including online students, students whose	
13			programs require laboratory access, and graduate students, as well as any other	
14			categories of students;	
15		<u>b.</u>	Develop a system of weighted student costs, one of which could include the size	
16			of the educating institution; and	
17		<u>C.</u>	Assume that historic spending levels are the initial indicator of the actual cost of	
18			educating students.	
19	<u>3.</u>	The	North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall provide reports to the	
20		<u>legi</u>	slative management and the state board of higher education during the 2011-12	
21		inte	rim and the 2013-14 interim.	
22	SEC	TIOI	5. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through December 31, 2014, and	
23	after tha	t dat	e is ineffective.	
24	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
