- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 14-05 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a waiting period for divorce and to mandatory marital counseling.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 14-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Divorce proceeding Waiting period Mandatory marital counseling.</u>
- In an action for divorce which includes the issue of parental rights and responsibilities
 and which does not include substantiated allegations of domestic abuse, the court
 may not issue a final order for at least twelve months from the date of the filing of the
- 10 <u>petition.</u>
- Within the twelve-month waiting period, the adult parties to the action shall participate
 jointly or separately in at least ten 1-hour marital counseling sessions. The marital
 counseling, which may be provided by a paid or volunteer counselor, clergy member,
 or any state-certified or licensed marriage mediator, must include at least four
- 15 sessions that focus on postmarital financial planning.
- 16 <u>3.</u> The court may not require both parents to attend the same course at the same time.
- Each party shall arrange for participation in the marital counseling sessions. The
- parties are responsible for the fees or costs of the marital counseling sessions. The
- 19 court may assess the counseling fees or costs as the court deems equitable.
- 4. A final decree may not be granted or a final order may not be entered until each party
 submits to the court certification of completion of the marital counseling.
