A BILL ~~for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota~~
~~Century Code, relating to verification of eligibility of voters.~~ for an Act to provide for a legislative
management study of election laws, campaign contribution and expenditure reporting
requirements, and reporting of legislative travel and financial interests.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

~~SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created~~
~~and enacted as follows:~~

~~Verification of voter upon filing of written complaint.~~

~~Upon receipt of a written complaint alleging an individual has violated subsection 3, 4, or 7~~
~~of section 16.1-01-12, a county auditor or the chief election officer in any local election shall~~
~~investigate the complaint by attempting to obtain satisfactory proof of the individual's eligibility to~~
~~vote in that election. Notwithstanding subsection 4 of section 16.1-02-05, the county auditor or~~
~~other election officer shall determine the residence of the individual for voting purposes by~~
~~personally contacting the individual at the address listed by the individual and verifying the~~
~~individual's eligibility to vote. If the investigation of the county auditor or other election officer~~
~~reveals that the individual resides at any address other than that provided to the election board~~
~~by the individual, the county auditor or other election official shall refer the matter to the state's~~
~~attorney for further investigation to determine if the individual has committed a violation of~~
~~subsection 3, 4, or 7 of section 16.1-01-12 or any other provision of law. A state's attorney~~
~~receiving a referral under this section shall perform the requested investigation and provide a~~
~~written report to the county auditor or other election officer within ninety days which summarizes~~
~~the findings of the investigation and any action taken as a result of the investigation.~~

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ELECTION LAWS, CAMPAIGN
CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES, TRAVEL REPORTING, AND STATEMENTS OF

1 **INTERESTS.** During the 2011-12 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying
2 election laws, campaign contribution and expenditure reporting requirements, and reporting of
3 legislative travel and financial interests. The legislative management shall report its findings and
4 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
5 the sixty-third legislative assembly.
