3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - HUMANE TREATMENT OF

- 5 **ANIMALS.** During the 2011-12 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying laws
- 6 pertaining to the humane treatment of animals for the purpose of reviewing their content and
- 7 their applicability to domestic or companion animals and to animals in production agriculture,
- 8 and recommending necessary policy changes to laws that are found to be irrelevant,
- 9 inconsistent, illogically arranged, not reflective of current practices or needs, or unclear in their
- 10 intent and direction. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,
- 11 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-third
- 12 legislative assembly.
